(The Institution and Excelsoft are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party').

### WHEREAS:

3.1. Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party, any right, title, interest or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

#### 4. CONFIDENTIALITY

The Parties agree: (a) to use each other's Confidential Information solely in accordance with 4.1. the provisions of this MoU; and (b) not to disclose, or permit to be disclosed, either directly or indirectly, Confidential Information to any third party without the other's prior written consent. ## NON-BINDING OBLIGATIONS

7.1. Except for the provisions of Section 4, this MoU is not intended to create any legally binding obligations upon the Parties in connection with the subject matter hereof and, for the avoidance of doubt, either Party may, at its sole discretion and without providing any reason thereafter, decline or refuse to enter into the Definitive Documents or to be bound by any other legal documents with the Parties pursuant to the terms of this MoU.

#### RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES B

It is expressly agreed that Institution and Excelsoft are acting under this MOU as 8.1. independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

In keeping with the desire of the king, Sri. Narasappa founded a school and named it Sarada Vilas Anglo-Sanskrit School. In the beginning, it was housed in a temple and later shifted to the Lansdowne building.

In 1899, the king formed a Governing Body to manage the affairs of the school Sri. M. Venkatakrishnalah, popularly called Tatalah, was named the Secretary. He was mainly instrumental in developing the Institution. In 1904, the school was shifted to the Lansdowne building. The High school section was started in 1917 which was shifted to its own building in 1931.

In 1945, the Institution started Sarada Vilas College offering Intermediate Course with Sri. M.S. Ramaswamy as Founder Principal. In the year 1952, it was upgraded and began to offer the B.Se course.

The Institution expanded its activities further by starting Law Collage in 1954, Girls High School in 1961, Teachers College in 1963 and Pharmacy College in 1992.

The institution is affiliated to University of Mysore, Mysore, India.





#### 6. Placement

#### 12 Termination

#### 14. Force Majoure







CITYONTHENET MARKETPLACE SERVICES PVT LTD., Registered Office situated at # 108, Il Floor, Shenoy Sadan, 9<sup>th</sup> Main Road, 3<sup>th</sup> Cross, Saraswathypuram, Mysore-570 009 in the Karnataka State represented by Mr. Satheesh Ramanna, its Director (hereinafter referred to as "CityonNet.com", which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors-in-office, administrators and assigns). (The institution and CityonNet.com are hereinafter jointly referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party").
