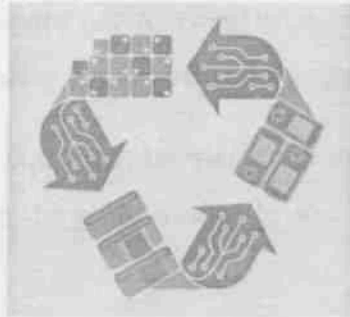

THIS AGREEMENT FOR DISPOSAL OF E-WASTE IS ENTERED ON THIS 7th DAY OF JUNE, 2022 BY AND BETWEEN:

M/s. Sarada Vilas college, an institute under Sarada Vilas Educational institutions located in Mysore city and having its Registered Office and College at Krishnamurthyapuram Mysore 50004 Karnataka, India hereinafter called the **OWNER** (which expression shall unless repugnant to the context thereof, shall mean and include its Successors, Executors, Administrators and Assigns), of the **FIRST PART**.

AND

M/s. NPE WASTE PRIVATE LIMITED a Company incorporated under the Companies Act, 2013 and having its Registered Office at No.11, A-1 Block, Rangarao Colony, Vasu Layout, Mysuru – 570 018 Karnataka, INDIA, its Premises situated at No.96, Koorgalli, Industrial Area, Belavdi Post, Mysuru – 570 018 Karnataka, INDIA, hereinafter called the **BUYER**, (which expression shall unless repugnant to the context thereof, shall mean and include its Successors, Executors, Administrators and Assigns), of the **OTHERPART**.

The Owner running educational institutions desires the Electronic Wastes generated in its Office and Work Place, (more particularly described in the Annexure-A) and hereinafter referred to as E-wastes, to be collected and disposed in a safe and lawful manner.

AND WHEREAS, the Buyer has an established recycling facility at the above referred premises for storing in a secured manner and recycling components for recovery of usable parts and metals using approved methodology and has obtained KSPCB Authorisation for Recycling of E-waste Authorization No.PCB/WMC/644/E-waste/2021/745 dated: 05.05.2022 valid up to 30.06.2026 for Storage & recycling of E-waste and the Owner has agreed to appoint the Buyer to collect and dispose E-Waste on the terms agreed below.

THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. PERIOD OF THE AGREEMENT:

This Agreement shall commence from the date 7th June 2022 and shall be valid for a period up to 6th June, 2023 This Agreement may be renewed by mutual consent of the parties.

2. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

a. The Buyer shall collect the E-waste mentioned in ANNEXURE –A at the prices, frequency and conditions mentioned therein and shall abide by the Guidance for adherence to Environmental Management Systems and ISO 14001 Compliances as laid down in ANNEXURE – B. The Owner shall from time to time amend the ANNEXURE –A to make any modifications, additions or deletion as may be required.

b. Buyer shall make payment to the Owner, for E-wastes collected from Owners premises, by Demand Draft or NEFT Account Transfer, against the Invoice raised by the Owner at the time of collection of E-waste.

c. The E-waste shall be collected by the Buyer at intervals as directed by the owner.

3. NO SERVICE LIABILITY:

a. No Employees or persons deployed by the Buyer in the premises of the Owner for the collection of E-wastes shall at no circumstances be the employees of the Owner and The Owner shall not be responsible for the salary and allowances of the Employees or persons deployed by the Buyer.

b. The Owner shall not be responsible to provide transportation facilities/food to the workforce and employees of the Buyer.

4. COMPLIANCE WITH ALL RELEVANT LAWS:

a. The Buyer shall comply with all the requirements of Pollution Control Board and other relevant laws in force as may be applicable in relation to collection, transportation, processing and disposing the E-wastes.

b. The Buyer shall be solely responsible for proper transportation, handling, cleaning, storage and disposal of all E-wastes collected from the Owner, according to statutory laws and approval of KSPCB. In the event of any breach of terms and conditions of this agreement or the authorization of pollution control board or the terms of any other statutory laws, approvals in force, orders or notifications of the Government, the BUYER hereby agrees to defend the Owner and keep the owner fully indemnified against all claims, liabilities, fees, penalties arising therefrom.

c. The Buyer shall cover his personal or employees with E.S.I., E.P.F., Insurance coverage and such other social welfare coverages, as applicable under various statutes and the owner shall not be responsible for any such dues.

d. The Buyer would be solely responsible for any workmen compensation claims arising out of this agreement.

5. TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT:

- a. If the Buyer fails to discharge his duties to the satisfaction of the Owner, the Owner can terminate the Agreement without Notice.
- b. Notwithstanding anything contained herein above this agreement shall stand terminated if the approval granted by the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board under the E-waste (Management) Rules, 2016 or any other law stands terminated, withdrawn or is not renewed. The Buyer shall immediately bring to the notice of the owner the fact of withdrawal, cancellation or non-renewal of the approvals by KSPCB or any other authority.


6. RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES:

- a. If any differences or disputes arise in connection with this or out of this Agreement, the same shall be amicably settled by mutual discussion, failing which the same shall be settled in accordance with the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modifications or re-enactments for the time being in force. b. It is mutually agreed between the parties that the courts of Bengaluru alone will have jurisdiction on all matters arising out of this Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the OWNER and the BUYER have executed this AGREEMENT, at Mysore, on the day first entered above, in two sets and each party shall retain one set each. Both sets shall read as a single agreement.

About Sarada Vilas Education Institute

The saga of **Sarada Vilas Educational Institutions** began in the year **1861** when His Highness **Mummadi Sri. Krishna raja Wodeyar**, the then ruler of Mysore state, directed his court man **Rao Bahadur Sri. Bhakshi Narasappa** to start an Educational Institution in Mysore so as to make the town a Centre for Education.

In keeping with the desire of the king, **Sri. Narasappa** founded a school and named it **Sarada Vilas Anglo-Sanskrit School**. In the beginning, it was housed in a temple and later shifted to the Lansdowne building.

In 1899, the king formed a Governing Body to manage the affairs of the school. **Sri. M. Venkatakrishnaiah**, popularly called **Tataiah**, was named the Secretary. He was mainly instrumental in developing the Institution. In 1904, the school was shifted to the Lansdowne building. The High school section was started in 1917 which was shifted to its own building in 1931.

In 1945, the Institution started an **Intermediate College** with **Sri. M.S. Ramaswamy** as Founder Principal. In the year 1952, it was upgraded and began to offer the **B.Sc** course.

The Institution expanded its activities further by starting **Law Collage** in 1954, **Girls High School** in 1961, **Teachers College** in 1963 and **Pharmacy College** in 1992.

I. Scope of this MoU

Joint Responsibility.

1. Cooperation: Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within their related constituents. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

General terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU.

The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

2. Collaboration on Academic Activities: This MOU is developed for the purpose of facilitating exchange activities between the parties. The goals of collaboration on academic activities contained in the Memorandum of Understanding include the following:

- d. To conduct student oriented activities like trainings, workshops etc.

3. Exchange of resources: At this time, there is no specific plan for the exchange of faculty or students; however, these may be discussed in the future. Any exchanging of either faculty or students would require a separate and specific agreement of cooperation.

4. Joint Publications & Exchange of Knowledge Resource: Joint publications of research articles, papers, books to develop research aptitude and to contribute to the world of knowledge. Share books, audio-videos, publications, reports and other teaching aids. Use each other's infrastructure such as auditorium, playground, and classrooms to host

II. FINANCIAL COMMITMENTS.

There is no financial commitment on the part of the **Sarada Vilas Education Institute** the First Party to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately. Similarly there are no financial or monetary commitments on the part of the **Sri. H. D. Devegowda Government First Grade College** the Second Party to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

III. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

It is expressly agreed that **Sarada Vilas Education Institute** and **Sri. H. D. Devegowda Government First Grade College** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership.

Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Par.

V. AMENDMENTS TO THE MOU:

No amendment or modification of this MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this MoU. The modifications / changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made / executed unless otherwise agreed to.

VI. ASSIGNMENT OF THE MOU

The rights or / and liabilities arising to any part of this MoU shall not be assigned except with the written consent of the other party and subject to such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon between the involved parties.

VII. VALIDITY

The term of this MOU shall commence on the date that it is signed by both parties and will continue in force and effect for a period of 5 years unless it is terminated sooner. Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This **Memorandum of Understanding** (hereinafter called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this the Eighteenth day of May, Two thousand Twenty by and between **SARADA VILAS COLLEGE** an Educational Institution forming part of Sarada Vilas Educational Institutions® situated at Sarada Vilas Road, Krishnamurthy Puram, Mysore 570 004 in the State of Karnataka represented herein by **Mr.B.S.Parthasarathy, President** (Authorised Person) hereinafter referred to as the "**Institution**", which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors-in-office, administrators and assigns).

AND

HoloSuit Pte Ltd. Situated at #22 Malacca Street, #04-03 RB Capital Building, SINGAPORE 048980, represented by **Mr.Harsha Kikkeri**, its **Managing Director**(hereinafter referred to as "**Holosuit**", which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors-in-office, administrators and assigns).

(The Institution and Holosuit are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party').

WHEREAS:

- (A) The Institution is a Higher Educational Institution named: **SARADA VILAS COLLEGE** has been in the field of education from last 75 years, affiliated to the University of Mysore and has now proposed to commence the undergraduate course, viz., **BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (HONORS)(Data Science and Artificial Intelligence) [B.Sc.(Hon's)(DS & AI)]** from the Academic Year 2020-21 approved as a Specialized Course affiliated to the University of Mysore, Mysore, India ;
- (B) **HoloSuit Pte Ltd.**, (the Holosuit) is engaged in the business of manufacturing and R&D Services in the fields of *Media and Entertainment, Robotics, Human Machine Interface, Artificial Intelligence, Robotics, Virtual Reality, Augmented Reality, Smart Textiles, Internet of Things, Animation* and other related fields;

- (C) Institution & HoloSuit believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities;
- (D) The Parties, therefore, intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on collaboration within area of Skill Based Training, and Education and Research for advancing their mutual interests on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CO-OPERATION

- 1.1. Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2. The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The terms of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

2. SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 2.1. The budding graduates and other students from the Institution could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both Parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2. **Curriculum Design:** HoloSuit will give valuable inputs to the Institution in teaching and training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students will fit into the expectations of industries meaningfully;

- 2.3. **Skill Development Programs:** HoloSuit to train the students and the faculty of the Institution on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready, through workshops, internal and final year projects.
- 2.4. **Guest Lectures:** HoloSuit to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the Institution on the technology trends and in- house requirements.
- 2.5. **Faculty Development Programs:** HoloSuit to train the Faculty members of the Institution for imparting training as per the industrial requirements, considering the National Occupational Standards in the concerned sector, if available.
- 2.6. **Industrial Training and Visits:** HoloSuit and the Institution interaction will give an insight into the advancements/ latest developments/ requirement of the industries. HoloSuit will permit the faculty members and the students of the Institution to visit its group companies and also involve the students in Industrial Training Programs of the Institution. The industrial training and exposure provided to the students will build confidence and prepare the students to make a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Institution will offer its facilities of labs and workshops for the hands-on training of the students enrolled with the Institution.
- 2.7. **Placement of Trained Students:** HoloSuit will actively engage to help the delivery of training and opportunities for internship and project work to students of the Institution at the sole discretion of HoloSuit and will assist and facilitate placements for at least 60% of the students.
- 2.8. Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for complying with the terms of this MoU.

3. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1. Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party, any right, title, interest or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

4. CONFIDENTIALITY

- 4.1. The Parties agree: (a) to use each other's Confidential Information solely in accordance with the provisions of this MoU; and (b) not to disclose, or permit to be disclosed, either directly or indirectly, Confidential Information to any third party without the other's prior written consent. Each Party may disclose Confidential Information only to those

employees and students on a need-to-know basis, provided that such employee/student is bound in writing by substantially similar confidentiality terms. Each Party shall safeguard the Confidential Information of the other Party using the same measures it uses to protect its own Confidential Information, but in no event shall either Party use less than reasonable care.

- 4.2. For the purpose of this MoU, "Confidential Information" shall mean any and all documents and other information, whether or not in tangible form, marked or confirmed as "Confidential" and disclosed by one Party to the other. Hardware, Robots, any software and accompanying documentation and information of Holosuit shall be deemed "Confidential Information" of Holosuit regardless of whether or not it is marked as such.
- 4.3. If a Party breaches, or threatens to breach the provisions of this section, the Parties agree that the non-breaching Party would be entitled to immediate injunctive and other equitable relief.
- 4.4. The confidentiality obligations contained in this clause shall survive for a period of three (3) years after the termination or expiration of this MoU.

5. VALIDITY

- 5.1. This MoU will be valid and remain in effect until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms. In the event of termination, both parties have to discharge their respective obligations.
- 5.2. Either Party may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing to the other.
- 5.3. Upon termination of this MoU, Institution shall return to Holosuit all Confidential or proprietary Information.

6. LIABILITY

- 6.1. In no event shall either Party be liable to the other for consequential or indirect losses or damages howsoever arising under this MoU and whether under contract, tort or otherwise (including, without limitation, third party claims, loss of profits, loss of customers, or damages to reputation or goodwill).

7. NON-BINDING OBLIGATIONS

- 7.1. Except for the provisions of Section 4, this MoU is not intended to create any legally binding obligations upon the Parties in connection with the subject matter hereof and, for the avoidance of doubt, either Party may, at its sole discretion and without providing any reason thereafter, decline or refuse to enter into the Definitive Documents or to be bound by any other legal documents with the Parties pursuant to the terms of this MoU.

8. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 8.1. It is expressly agreed that **Institution** and **HoloSuit** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. 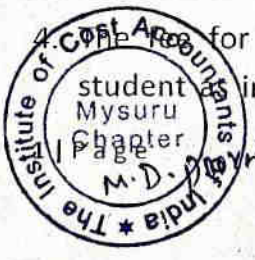
This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into on 9th August 2019 by and between

And

SARADA VILAS COLLEGE affiliated to the University of Mysore and having its college campus situated at Saradavilas Road, Krishnamurthy Puram, Mysore-570004 Karnataka State and represented by Mr.B.S.Parthasarathy, President, Sarada Vilas Educational Institutions®, governing body of **Sarada Vilas College** (hereafter referred to as **SECOND PARTY**).

Whereas both FIRST and SECOND parties hereinabove mentioned have mutually agreed to enter into an agreement for better understanding of the terms of the agreement set out hereunder:

1. Whereas, the FIRST PARTY is a statutory body formed under an Act of Parliament called as "The Institute of Cost & Works Accountants of India Act of 1959", formed to conduct coaching and examinations of students for pursuing career as the Cost & Management Accountants. 3. The Institute of Cost Accountants of India (ICAI), Mysore Chapter of ICAI hereby grant its permission to set-up Extended Oral Coaching Centre to conduct FOUNDATION COURSE at Sarada Vilas College.



4. Cost for the Foundation Course shall be Rs,4,000/- or such fee per student as informed by the ICAI from time to time to be remitted to the

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
account of The Institute of Cost Accountants of India at Branch of IDBI or Punjab National Bank through prescribed challan available in the Prospectus.

5. First Party or its representatives have the right to visit the Second Party and inspect all related documents.
6. Out of the fee of Rs.4,000/- remitted by the student under para 4 above, an amount of Rs.2,500/- per student will be shared between the Mysore Chapter of ICAI and the Second Party on mutually agreed terms based on the number of students registered.
7. The Second Party shall ensure appointment of faculties with appropriate qualification and experience as specified by the ICAI from time to time.
8. The Second Party shall conduct classes in a students' friendly atmosphere and conduct tests regularly.
9. This understanding is reached based on good faith and support to be extended by both the First Party and the Second Party to conduct coaching for the Foundation Course of ICAI.
10. It is the responsibility of the ^{First} ~~Second~~ Party to pay remuneration mutually agreed by both the parties to the faculty and incur all administrative expenses for conducting the coaching classes.
11. The prescribed number of classes to be conducted is as per the approach plan issued by the ICAI.
12. The Second Party has to arrange career counselling programs in the colleges nearby its vicinity and promote this professional course.
13. The Second Party has to promote this professional course during admission in their college.
14. The Second Party has to identify a person as the Co-ordinator for coordinating activities with the Mysore Chapter.
15. The Co-ordinator needs to take care of the activities detailed in Annexure-III in coordination with the Mysore Chapter.

16. The First Party will provide all required training to the Co-ordinator.
17. The **FIRST PARTY** reserves the right to cancel the 'Extended Oral Coaching Centre' without assigning any reason, in case, it feels that conduct of the classes is not in the required manner without assigning any reason to Second Party.
18. In case of any disputes, the arbitration shall be restricted to Mysore jurisdiction.
19. This Memorandum of Understanding is agreed by both the parties along with the rules for guidance for the Extended Oral Coaching Centre at the College. The rules for accrediting Oral Coaching Centre is indicated in Annexure-I and the Profile Guidance to the students for enrolling for Foundation Course is indicated in Annexure-II hereof.



National Association of Software and Service Companies (NASSCOM) having its head office at Plot No. - 7-10, Sector- 126, Noida, Uttar Pradesh - 201303, India (hereinafter called "NASSCOM/First Party"), represented by the Executive Director IT-ITeS Sector Skills Council NASSCOM, which expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executors and administrators of the FIRST PART.


And

Sarada Vilas Educational Institutions, having its head office at Sarada Vilas Road, Krishnamurthy Puram, Mysore-570004, Karnataka, (hereinafter referred to as "SVET."), represented by the President Sarada Vilas Educational Institutions, Mysore, which expression shall, where the context so admits be deemed to include its successor in office, legal representatives and permitted assigns of the SECOND PART

Whereas IT-ITeS Sector Skills Council NASSCOM (SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM) an integral part of NASSCOM is the skill standard setting body of the IT-ITeS Industry and is also the education & skill development initiative of NASSCOM; SSC NASSCOM works with its industry members and select academic and skill development institutions to help improve the quality and quantity of the employable workforce available to this industry;

The 'Project' here is the "Qualification Pack (QP) based training programs" developed with an objective of scaling quality capacity.

NASSCOM / SSC NASSCOM and SVET can herein be referred to independently as 'First Party', and 'Second Party' respectively and collectively referred to as 'Parties'.

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THE MoU WITNESSED AND THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Objective of the MoU

- (a) Increase the employability of students in the SVET and colleges under the aegis of the SVET by facilitating the development and introduction of the QP-based training programs
- (b) Help facilitate a sustainable Faculty Development Program
- (c) Facilitate teaching-learning support for pursuance of the said course/s to enhance student employability
- (d) Recommend relevant courseware, certain books, e-tools, e-content and websites to support the self-paced learning for students
- (e) Introduce the skill assessment/metric for QP-based assessments for students at the entry level, in conjunction with the programs, to analyse the efficacy of the multiple skill development programs
- (f) Introduce the skill assessment/metric for QP-based assessments for students, to facilitate employment at the entry level
- (g) Facilitate students towards QP certification via these newly introduced course/s during the UG program and appear for the QP assessment at the appropriate NSQF level (National Skills Qualification Framework)
- (h) Establish Centres of Excellence (CoE) for skill development


2. Period of MoU

This MoU shall come into force on 3rd June 2019 and will be valid for a period of three years from the said date, and after the expiry of the said time period is open to extension as per mutually agreed terms and conditions.

3. Responsibility of NASSCOM / SSC NASSCOM

NASSCOM/ SSC NASSCOM agrees to:

- (a) share the list of QPs in IT Services (ITS), Software Products (SPD), Engineering Research & Development (ERD) and Business Process Management (BPM) sub-sectors that are preferred by the industry / are of interest to industry
- (b) Help the SVET identify the QPs, for which Elective Courses will be developed and offered for students
- (c) Existing Curricula and courseware can be availed at cost (per QP).
 - i. Curricula OBFs can be availed at cost INR 5000/- + applicable per QP, OBF.
 - ii. Further to utilize the concerned courseware for Faculty/student trainings will attract one-time cost for QP courseware (per courseware) including both Facilitator Guide and Student Handbook (only as soft copy) at the original price of INR 200,000/- (Two Lacs only) plus all the applicable taxes per QP per organization, will be at a discounted price of INR 100,000/- (One Lakh only) plus all the applicable taxes, per QP only for an educational Institution or NASSCOM Member. This amount is payable through the SSC NASSCOM payment gateway/DD.




Furthermore the courseware is also available online i.e. the Facilitator Guide/Participant Handbook is available as a flip book with an one year license at INR 500/- + applicable taxes per candidate/user.

- iii. IP of the courseware/s and OBF curriculum/la developed shall lie with NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM
 - iv. Train at cost, select faculty from identified colleges (nominated by SVET who would participate in the development of QP-based programs) and from identified Third Party Training Providers, as nominated jointly by SVET as one batch [of 25 per QP (Qualification Pack)], as 'Master Faculty/Trainers'
- (d) The modus operandus of Master Faculty training is to be detailed and directed consultatively by SVET and NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM
 - (e) Facilitate a consultative approach by helping SVET set up a "WORKING GROUP" to identify Third Party Training Providers, if required. This group will also be empowered to take decisions on modalities/logistics for the smooth roll out of the program.
 - (f) Provide the necessary guidelines for a skill development cycle and the information w.r.t. Infrastructure requirements for the program regarding the QP concerned, as indicated in the Outcomes Based Framework for the same.
 - (g) The Outcomes Based Framework for each of the QPs and the Certification for the same will be provided/facilitated by NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM @INR 5000/- exclusive of taxes (per QP) for the SVET. SVET may choose to use the curricula of the QP concerned in the OBF format, or go in for the Curriculum Alignment for the same as per their own requirement, at cost (@INR 5000/- exclusive of taxes per QP). Taxes as applicable will paid by the Parties concerned.
 - (h) Post the conduct of training, facilitate assessments of candidates/students on QPs at cost (presently at INR 1,000/- at NSQF Level 4, INR 1100/ at Level 5-7 and INR 1250 /at Level 8 and above, per student per test, exclusive of taxes), via identified assessment providers of NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM. Taxes as applicable will paid by SVET
 - (i) QP based assessment for faculty w.r.t. TVET QPs (ie Teaching Pedagogy) is presently applicable at INR 1200/- per assessment, exclusive of taxes. All applicable taxes have to be addressed by SVET
 - (j) Maintain a centralised employment portal which is aimed to facilitate the employability of students that are trained and assessed using QP-based assessments
 - (k) Provide an analysis of student performance on the basis of the scores attained. NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM and SVET jointly own the database of trained resources through, which would be shared with all NASSCOM members (including the ones who have provided their concurrence towards recognizing the program). Intent would be to increase the scope of employment opportunities.
 - (l) Facilitate the development of courseware guides/hand books for teachers and students respectively for the designed QP curriculum for Phase I QPs identified.

4. Responsibility of the SVET

- (a) Select the list of QPs, basis feedback from NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM for which training programs will be developed and deployed for students
- (b) Avail the courseware at cost for the identified QP from NASSCOM /SSC NASSCOM
- (c) Post availing the content, select colleges for Phase I of this project.

SVET will address the cost of curricula, courseware, facilitating Industry Trainers for the Master Training, TTT (Training the Trainer) and Student Training programs concerned; other related costs w.r.t. assessments for these programs will also be addressed by SVET

- (a) SVET shall address the advertisement and other promotional activities for promoting the development programs and use all audio visual and online media for the same. The form of advertisement and all promotional material shall be jointly agreed upon and cleared by both the Parties concerned before use
- (b) SVET will use NASSCOM /SSC NASSCOM material under this MoU solely for purpose providing knowledge to the faculty and students with the latest and relevant information, and shall not use the same for any other commercial purposes
- (c) SVET shall not use or permit the use of SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM material for the benefit of any entity other than those under the purview of SVET. It is expressly stated that this clause shall survive the termination of the MoU
- (d) SVET to provide any other assistance as may be required from time to time to further promotion or the management of the programs concerned


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- (d) Select faculty from the identified colleges (SVET to screen such faculty based on selection parameters prescribed by NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM), who will be trained on the programs along with the faculty from the Third Party Training Provider, so that they can handhold students during the Phase I
- (e) Identify the requisite number students from the SVET / colleges identified to undergo the training program and assessments
- (f) Facilitate QP-based assessments, at cost, for the target student audience w.r.t. the SVET

- (j) NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM and SVET to jointly own up database of trained resources, which would be shared with all NASSCOM members (including the ones who have provided their concurrence towards recognizing the program). Intent would be to increase the scope of employment opportunities
- (k) SVET to bear the cost of conducting the Master Trainer program, including the cost of Industry Trainers as indicated below in the Clause 'Funding'
- (l) SVET to conduct TTT and the subsequent student training at its own cost
- (m) For the conduct of QP based assessments SVET shall make 100% advance payment of assessment cost to NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM i.e. the First Party for all the batches for which the First Party shall have given acceptance against requisition and the First Party shall give an acknowledgement of advance payment.
- Assessment cost shall be paid on the basis of registered/scheduled number of candidates (this covers those passed, failed and also covers absentees on the day of the assessment as well) subject to a minimum batch-size, which is 30 candidates per batch. The cost for a QP assessment and the subsequent certification is currently is at INR.1000/- (exclusive of taxes). All applicable taxes, under various statutes if any, will be borne by the SVET
- (n) Other requirements for the smooth conduct of QP based assessments are indicated in:
- Annexure A: Information regarding the necessary infrastructure for the smooth conduct of assessments to be provided by SVET

Process:

Part-A:-

- (a) A 'Working Group', to be formed by SVET, comprising of members from SVET, Academia, SVET and Industry/NASSCOM

- (b) The Group shall identify the following:

- List of QPs for which training will be offered at SVET
- Avail curricula and courseware at cost by SVET for the identified QPs
- Identify colleges to be taken up for Phase I of the project

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NASSCOM/ SSC NASSCOM will support SVET in a job fair by facilitating the presence of member companies at no extra cost to itself for the placement of students certified for the QPs concerned

8. Trademark

The Parties agree that NASSCOM/ SSC NASSCOM logo, as shared by NASSCOM / SSC NASSCOM, shall be used in all promotion documents only post formal approval of the content by NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM.

9. Intellectual Proprietary rights in SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM material

- (a) The proprietary rights in relation to the material provided to SVET and its affiliated colleges w.r.t. QPs shall rest with NASSCOM /SSC NASSCOM: SVET shall have the right to use the curricula and course material in accordance to the terms of this MoU.
- (b) NASSCOM/ SSC NASSCOM is the owner of all the intellectual proprietary rights with regard to the training material thus developed (teacher and the taught), and neither this MoU nor the training material shall directly or indirectly create for SVET or colleges under its aegis any right, title or interest therein
- (c) SVET acknowledges and agrees that NASSCOM /SSC NASSCOM owns all rights, title/s and interest in NASSCOM /SSC NASSCOM training material/s, including, without limitation, all intellectual property rights and goodwill therein. SVET will not delete or alter in any manner the copyright, trademark and other proprietary rights, notices etc. appearing in the training material provided by NASSCOM/ SSC NASSCOM


10. Indemnity

SVET also hereby agrees to indemnify and hold NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM harmless from any loss, claim, damage, costs, taxes, duties, additions, penalties, interest thereon or expenses of any kind, including the attorney's fees if any, to which NASSCOM /SSC NASSCOM may be subjected to by virtue of any finding related to the terms of the MoU or by virtue of any contravention and non-compliance on the part of SVET and its affiliated colleges and vice-versa with any laws, ordinance, regulations and codes as may be applicable from time to time.

11. Jurisdiction and Arbitration

In the event of any or difference between the Parties hereto, the courts in Delhi alone shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try any matter arising between the Parties here-to and accordingly both the Parties shall submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts in Delhi as mutually decided at that time for this purpose.

5. Responsibility of NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM Test Provider

6. Placement

NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM partner companies (i.e. those supporting this project) shall have the first right to offer employment to the candidates at any time during or after completion of the course concerned.

NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM and SVET jointly own database of trained resources through, which would be shared with all NASSCOM members (including the ones who have provided their concurrence towards recognizing the program). Intent would be to increase the scope of employment opportunities

covered in this MoU, relevant to this program, and disputes etc arising about any aspect of the MoU shall be settled through mutual consultation and agreement, by the Parties to this MoU. In case a settlement is not arrived at, all disputes or differences arising between the parties in relation to the interpretation, meaning or effect of this agreement, or to any breach thereof and remain unresolved after the intervention of the representatives of the parties, shall be referred to arbitration under the aegis of the Indian Council of Arbitration at New Delhi (ICA). The Rules of the ICA shall govern the arbitral proceedings between the parties. The arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in English and the venue for the arbitration proceedings shall be New Delhi.

12. Termination

- (a) Either Party shall have the right to terminate the MoU, if the other Party commits a material breach of any of the terms and conditions of the MoU concerned and fails to rectify the same within 30 days of being requested to do so in writing.
- (b) In the eventuality of termination or non-renewal of MoU on expiry of MoU, it would be the responsibility of NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM to complete its commitment towards the project; SVET to also complete and provide its services to all students admitted as per the regulation of SVET with reference to the project identified in this MOU for the 'QP-based Program/ Course'. In such an eventuality, SVET will continue to use the learning material for students already enrolled for the Programs, subject to the official intimation of the anticipated day of closure.

13. Amendment of the MoU

If during the operation of MoU, circumstances may rise which call for alteration / modification to this MoU, such alteration / modification shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing with the approval of the appropriate authority of SVET and NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM. Such changes will be formalized in writing as an 'Addendum' to this MoU and will be deemed to be a part of this MoU.

14. Force Majeure

- (a) Notwithstanding anything contained elsewhere in the contract, the parties shall not be liable for liquidated damages or termination for default, if and to the extent that, its delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the contract is the result of an event of Force Majeure
- (b) For purposes of this Clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of Parties and not involving Parties and not involving fault or negligence not foreseeable by or beyond the control of Parties. Events also include wars or rebellion, strikes, bandhs, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes etc.
- (c) If a Force Majeure situation arises, either Party shall promptly notify the other in writing of such conditions and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by either the SVET or NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM, in writing, both Parties shall continue to perform their independent obligations under this MOU as far as reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event.

SVET or NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM can opt out of this MoU on mutually agreeable terms and conditions in writing, as the case may be, prompted by a Force Majeure.

This MOU is prepared as two originals (one for NASSCOM /SSC NASSCOM and for the SVET) and comes into force on the day when the Parties concerned have signed it.

(The Institution and CityonNet.com are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party').

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS AGREEMENT, THE PARTIES HEREIN AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

1. DEFINITIONS

- 1.1. **"Academic Fees"** means the total tuition fees collected by the College from a student who has enrolled for the Designated Programme across the duration of the entire programme;
- 1.2. **"Confidential Information"** means either party's proprietary information, financial information, technical data, trade secrets or know-how, including, but not limited to, product plans, products, services, markets, software, inventions, processes, technology, designs, marketing, finances or other business information disclosed by CityonNet.com, either directly or indirectly in writing, orally, the discussions covering the matters relating to this Agreement and any information that the College may come across or have access to during the tenure of the Agreement. All Software and CityonNet.com IP and accompanying documentation and information of CityonNet.com shall be deemed "Confidential Information" of CityonNet.com regardless of whether it is marked as such.

 - 2.2.1. **Interactive Lecture Sessions**, conducted by CityonNet.com subject matter experts ("SMEs") in the CityonNet.com Supported Courses to be taught by CityonNet.com as per agreed course credit hours;
 - 2.2.2. **Interactive workshops** conducted by CityonNet.com SMEs;

Notwithstanding the foregoing, neither party to this Agreement bears responsibility for safeguarding information that is: (i) publicly available not as a result of any breach of confidentiality by the receiving party; (ii) obtained from third parties not under confidentiality restrictions; (iii) proven to be in the possession of the receiving party at the time of disclosure; or (iv) upon notice to the disclosing party by the receiving party, required to be disclosed by order of a court or other government authority.

1. Background



December 22nd is a day of celebration for all Mathematicians in India. This day is celebrated as National Mathematics Day throughout the country. On this day, in 1887, born the legendary mathematician Srinivasa Ramanujan in a small place in Tamil Nadu. Difficulties mattered nothing to this genius, who was committed and passionate towards creating mathematics of his own. G.H. Hardy, one of the finest Mathematicians and also the man who introduced Ramanujan to the formal Mathematics describes his relationship with Ramanujan in his autobiography *A Mathematician's apology* as follows: "I still say to myself when I am depressed, and find myself forced to listen to pompous and tiresome people, 'Well, I have done one thing you could never have done, and that is to have collaborated with both Littlewood and Ramanujan on something like equal terms". These words of Hardy are enough to tell the impact Ramanujan had on World Mathematics Community. It is not an exaggeration if we tell that, even after a century Ramanujan has left us physically, most of the current research articles in the areas of q-series, modular equations and partition theory contain the name and ideas of Ramanujan. In recognition of the contribution of Ramanujan to Mathematics, in 2012 Central Government of India declared 22nd December of every year as the National Mathematics Day in India. Hence this day, 22nd December is a day of celebration for people working in Mathematics. To commemorate the birth day of Srinivasa Ramanujan, Sarada Vilas College in collaboration with Sri. H. D. Devegowda Government First Grade College organized a National level webinar on 27th December, 2021. Dr. C. S. Yogananda, Former professor, SJCE, Mysuru was invited as the speaker for the webinar.

2. Formalities

The webinar began with an introduction by Yathirajsharma M. V, Asst. Professor, Sarada Vilas College, who acted as the anchor. The guests were welcomed by Dr. Vijay Kumar, Asst. Professor, Sri. H. D. Devegowda Government First Grade College. This was followed by the encouraging speeches by the Principals of both the colleges, Dr. Devika M and Dr. G. D. Narayana. A brief introduction of the speaker was given by Ms. Pushpa K, Asst. Professor, Sarada Vilas College. This was followed by the talk by Dr. C. S. Yogananda and an interaction session. Finally the vote of thanks was given by Dr. Saroja Y Talwar, Asst. Professor, Sarada Vilas College.



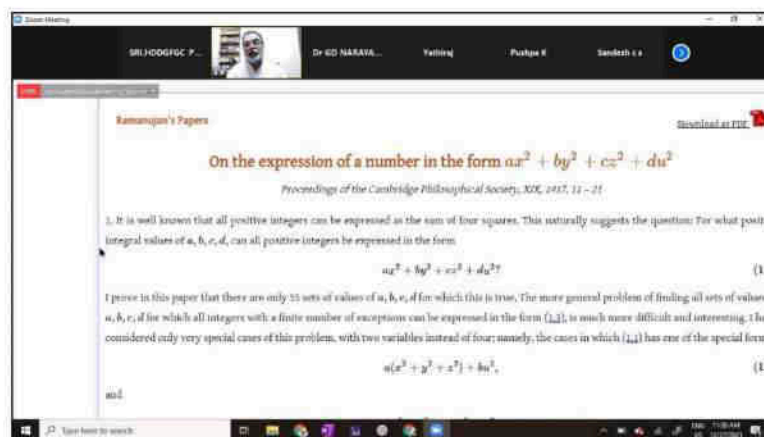

3. Webinar

The main objective of the webinar was to give glimpses of the way Ramanujan used to work. The author chose universal quadratic forms as the main example. Before beginning the talk on the actual topic, universal quadratic forms, the speaker showed the online repository of works of Ramanujan. It was the website www.ramanujan.sirinudi.org which can be accessed freely by anybody. Speaker mainly used this website to show the work of Ramanujan on universal quadratic forms and simultaneously used a presentation. Title of the presentation was “Universal quadratic forms from Ramanujan to Manjul Bhargava”. Speaker began with the meaning of quadratic forms and then explained how the problem of universal quadratic forms were perused by various mathematicians from Ramanujan to Manjul Bhargava including J. H. Conway. A universal quadratic form is a positive definite quadratic form with integer matrix which can represent all positive integers. The form which was considered by Ramanujan was the below one:

$$ax^2 + by^2 + cz^2 + dw^2.$$

Mathematicians were interested in finding the conditions on a, b, c and d for the above expression to be a universal quadratic form. Ramanujan showed that there were 55 possibilities on a, b, c and d for the above form to represent all natural numbers. This was true, provided all the coefficients, a, b, c and d were positive. Later, mathematicians became interested in the problem of finding the conditions on generalized quadratic forms to be universal. For instance, J. H. Conway and Schneeberger found out a way that for a positive definite quadratic form with integer entries to be a universal quadratic form, it is enough to check if it represented all natural numbers from 1 to 15. Similarly Manjul Bhargava perused the same work and proved the 290 conjecture of Conway.

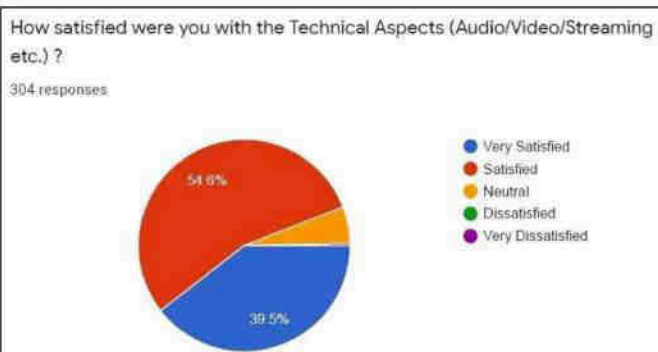
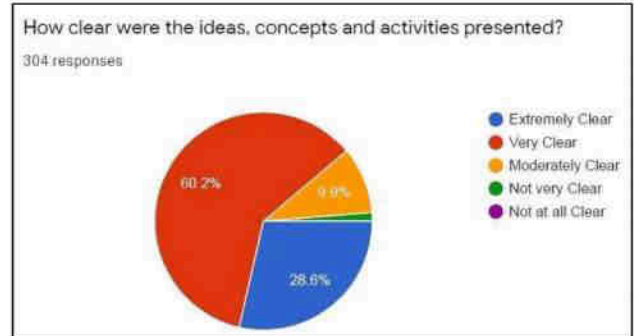
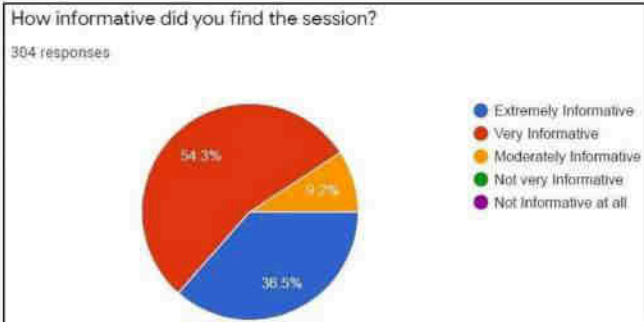


Speaker showing the original paper of Ramanujan

This was a small journey kind of story from Ramanujan to Manjul Bhargava. Speaker finished the talk by showing few pages of Ramanujan's notebooks (like the taxi cab number's page and number of representation of 4^{th} power of some number as sum of 4^{th} powers of some other numbers). After finishing the talk, speaker asked students' to interact if any. Speaker himself encouraged students to pursue further by asking a question on sums of squares. Few students enthusiastically interacted, thought, and responded to the question of the speaker. This was a lesson by the speaker, to question oneself similar kinds of questions which they encountered in any talk.

4. Statistics

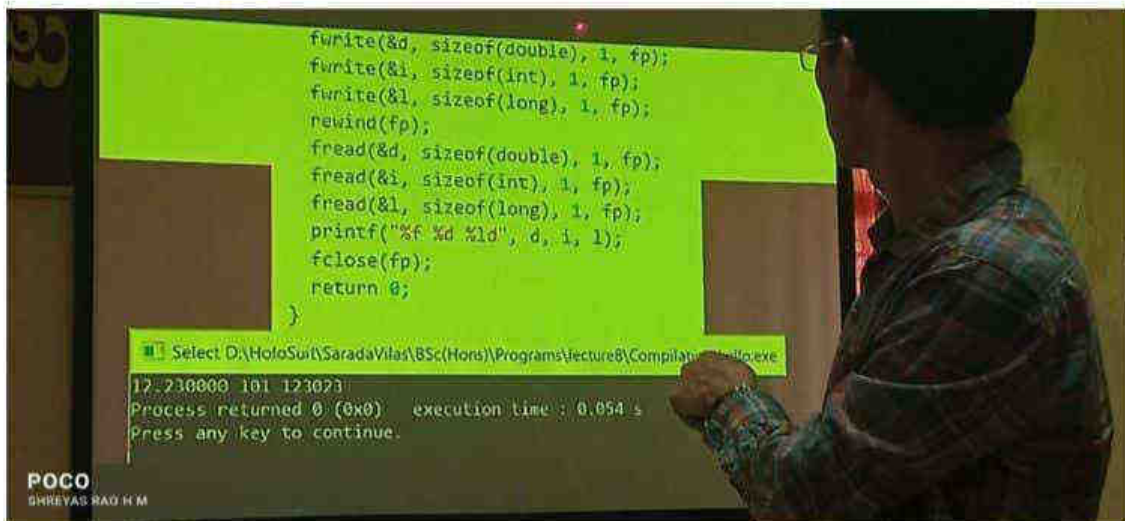

6. COACHING SCHEME
The objective of Coaching is to impart training to the students to enable them to pass the examination and develop the professional aptitude and competence. A student eligible for admission to a course has to undergo and complete Coaching for the relevant course.

6.1 TWO MODES OF COACHING
(i) **Private Coaching**
(ii) **Oral Coaching**

6.2 FEES FOR COACHING
(Refer Annexure V)

(A) Students opting Private Coaching Scheme can:-
(1) Register and pay the fee either by credit/debit card or net banking.
(2) Deposit the prescribed fee in cash at any branch of **Public National Bank, IDBI Bank or Central Bank of India** (in any four states), available in the student's download section of www.cmaaii.org.

(B) Students opting Oral Coaching Scheme can:-
