## Proceedings of IQAC meeting held on January 31.2018

IQAC meeting was held on 31st January 2018 at 12.45 pm in Principal's Chamber. Dr. M. Govindaraju welcomed the members. Meeting was attended by Dr. T.K. Umesh, Prof. DoS in Physics, University of Mysore (Expert member), Sri B.S. Parthasarathy, President SVEI, Sri H.K. Srinath, Hon. Secretary, SVEI, Dr. M. Govindaraju, Dr. R. Gururaja, Dr. G.Viswanath, Smt. M. Devika, Dr. Satyanarayana, Dharan Chandrapal, Alumni member, Druva Chipli, Student representative and Principal Dr K.J. Muralidhara. After due deliberations the committee took the following decisions.

1. Review of post NAAC initiatives. Research activities taken up by the faculty members were reviewed. Teachers were asked to be proactive in the research activity.
2. Steps to be taken to improve the admissions to post graduate course in Chemistry
3. Establishment of full-fledged laboratory for PG courses and improvement of Physical infrastructure.
4. President of the Institution Sri B.S. Parthasarathy informed that 12 rooms will be available from 2018 for the engagement of classes and PG labs will be established in the newly constructed PG block
5. In view of the retirement of a few staff members associated with IQAC, it was decided to reconstitute the IQAC.
